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8. **Description of the Project:**

The SPM<sup>2</sup> project aims to revolutionize project management education across Europe by integrating sustainability into the widely adopted European Commission PM<sup>2</sup> methodology. This project focuses on empowering students and professionals with the skills needed to lead eco-conscious projects that align with the EU Green Deal and the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

The project will develop innovative learning tools, including a comprehensive digital platform, standardized curricula, and micro-credentials for sustainability-focused project management roles. By collaborating with higher education institutions (HEIs), vocational education and training (VET) centers, and industry stakeholders, SPM<sup>2</sup> will ensure that future project managers are prepared to contribute to the green economy and global environmental challenges.

The main results of the project include:

- **Stakeholder Engagement, Needs Analysis, and Development of the SPM<sup>2</sup> Guide.** In-depth stakeholder engagement and needs analysis, leading to the creation of the SPM<sup>2</sup> Guide. This guide will provide key insights, tools, templates, and case studies for sustainable project management, tailored to both educational and professional environments.
- **Development of the SPM<sup>2</sup> Curriculum and Integration with the Digital Resource Hub.** Creation of a standardized curriculum focused on sustainable project management, combined with the integration of the digital resource hub. This hub will offer valuable resources, including online tools and templates, and support pilot testing to engage students and professionals.
- **Development and Pilot Testing of the SPM<sup>2</sup> Micro-Credentials Framework.** Creation and pilot implementation of a micro-credential framework for sustainable project management. This framework will offer modular, stackable credentials to help professionals demonstrate their expertise in sustainability within project management roles.
- **Dissemination, Knowledge Sharing, and Utilization of Results.** A comprehensive strategy to disseminate the project's outcomes, share knowledge, and ensure that SPM<sup>2</sup>'s methodologies and resources are widely adopted across Europe, contributing to the integration of sustainability in project management education.
