# Virtual University for Students

The main login system at UITM is the new portal available at my.wsiz.edu.pl

To sign in, you should use your student email address together with your password. By default, the password is your PESEL number, although in special situations you may receive a different one.


Each student email address is created according to the same rule: it is your album number followed by the domain, for example:

#### 12345@student.wsiz.edu.pl

Once you log in, you will gain access to many services without the need to sign in again, including the Virtual University (WU), email, Moodle, Webex, the Library, Plagiat.pl and others. In the same place you will also find your class schedule and the latest university news.

During the transition period, some apps may still ask you to log in again (use the same login and password as for my.wsiz.edu.pl).

Because of the new teaching system (VDO), information about the academic year 2025/26 is now available only in the new Virtual University, which is also adapted for mobile devices, unlike the old Smart WSIiZ app.



# Direct login to Virtual University (WU)

The Virtual University is available at: wu.wsiz.edu.pl

Logging in requires your student account via my.wsiz.edu.pl or the use of MFA.


MFA (Multi-Factor Authentication) is an extra layer of protection for your login: besides your password, you must confirm your identity with another method such as an SMS code, a mobile application, or a fingerprint. This means that even if somebody knows your password, they still cannot access your account without the second factor

If your browser does not remember any student account, the first page you see will be the Microsoft login screen, where you need to enter your student email, password, and complete the second step using the Authenticator app on your smartphone.

# Homepage

After logging in, the homepage will open with basic information about your studies and links to more detailed sections.

You can always return to this homepage by clicking the university logo in the top-left corner.



#### The page has three columns:

1. The first shows your personal study data, such as the program or specialization you are enrolled in and your results from the last semester, including your average grade, the number of passed subjects, and the total number of collected ECTS points.






ECTS (European Credit Transfer System): 1 point = about 25–30 hours of study (classes + self-study). You collect them to complete subjects and your degree.

2. The second column contains your upcoming classes from the semester timetable.

From here you can also check your list of subjects, your semester statistics, and your progress towards meeting course requirements.



3. The third column is reserved for the most important announcements, such as deadlines for choosing a specialization or a thesis supervisor.

# **Navigation**

Navigation through the system is provided by the top menu bar, which on smaller screens becomes the so-called "hamburger menu."

#### Search

Magnifying glass icon: You can search for teachers by name and check where their next classes are held.


## Messages

**Envelope icon**: all messages from teachers (e.g. changes in classes or requirements).

By clicking on the subject of a message you can read its content in a side panel.


## Language

The Interface is available in Polish, English, Ukrainian.



#### Student account menu

In the student account menu you can log out or enter your profile page.



Here you can check and edit some of your personal data:

- personal info (parents' names, place of birth, PESEL),
- addresses (home, mailing, temporary),
- contact details (private and student email, phone number),
- change your student account password,
- upload/change your photo (must follow document rules).

#### You can also:

 order a physical Student ID card (ELS) with holograms for discounts (not required from academic year 2025/26).





manage your mLegitymacja (electronic ID card in the mObywatel app).

Physical ID cards must be validated every semester in the Dean's Office (usually done by your group leader).

Old ELS cards (before October 2025) are still valid until hologram space is finished.


Missing hologram does not affect the validity of your mLegitymacja, which can be extended online.

Since October 2025, the physical Student ID card (ELS) is no longer required. Instead, every student must have the electronic ID (mLegitymacja) in the mObywatel app.

Here you see your full and up-to-date semester timetable.


The calendar is interactive: use arrows, date ranges, or calendar icon to change views.



## **Subjects and Grades**

Shows all your subjects by semester, grade statistics, and completion progress.

Full completion (100%) is only visible when you have passed every required form of every subject. During an academic leave, the system will always show 0%.



When you click on a subject, you can see grades, surveys and the course syllabus.

Clicking on the teacher's name will show information about their upcoming classes.
