Choosing a Thesis Supervisor for Students

The option to choose your thesis supervisor will be available on the main page of the Virtual University (WU), which you can access by selecting the **WU** tile on <u>my.wsiz.edu.pl</u>

In the central part of your dashboard, you will see a dark-blue banner — it will either show a **countdown** (if the official time for selecting a supervisor has not yet started or has already ended) or a link allowing you to **register for your seminar class**.



After clicking the **Sign up for classes** (pl: Zapisz się na zajęcia) button, you will be redirected to the **Registration page**, where you will find a list of compulsory subjects you must now enrol in.

In this case, it will be Diploma Seminar part 1, which represents the first semester of your diploma project work.

Alternatively, you can reach the registration page through: Subjects and Grades → Registration.

Under the course title (click it), you will see a list of all lecturers leading the seminar. One of them will become your thesis supervisor until you complete your studies — this person will help you choose your thesis topic and support you throughout the process of writing, collecting data, and conducting research.



In the course list, you can see not only the potential supervisors but also the number of hours and ECTS credits assigned for the semester. If you want to check the number of available spots in a particular group, simply click on it. A side panel will open, showing this information as well as the meeting times (click **All dates** (pl: wszystkie terminy) to view them).



To enrol in a group (and thus select your supervisor), click the blue **Sign up** (pl: Zapisz się) and wait until the first scheduled class begins. If necessary, you can still change your choice before classes start — you can withdraw from one group (pl: Wypisz się) and join another.

If you already have an idea for your diploma thesis or you are simply unsure which supervisor to choose, you can check each **lecturer's research interests**. This information is available in the **Lecturer Search tool** on WU \bigcirc , along with details about consultation hours and upcoming classes.
